

# The Golden Jubilee of 1865 Chicago Lodge 1915

**T**HE Golden Jubilee of Chicago Lodge is to be fittingly commemorated on Saturday evening, October 23, 1915, the exercises being held in Hotel La Salle, La Salle and Madison Streets, Chicago.

**The Affair**—The nature of the exercises is being kept secret merely to add to the surprise and enjoyment of the brethren.

**Eligibility**—Attendance is restricted to members of Chicago Lodge and their lady guests. Each member is privileged to bring one lady—no more. This is an ironclad rule and cannot be broken.

**The Start**—The festivities will start with a banquet at 7 o'clock P. M. sharp. The brethren are cautioned to be on hand promptly at the hour mentioned—the nature of the program requires it. Surely once in fifty years all of us can be on time. It is to be a long evening and we must start to talk and eat on time.

**Dress**—The dress is to be formal. However, if some of you older members are averse to putting on that dress suit again, why just come in the way you will feel most comfortable. We want all old timers still on the membership roll to be on hand for this affair, and they may decide the matter of dress to suit themselves.

**No Expense**—There will be absolutely no expense of any kind or nature for the members. Everything is paid for by the Lodge. Leave your money at home.

**Acceptances**—A card is enclosed herewith, on which the member must signify his intention regarding attendance. Upon receipt of your acceptance, tickets of admission will be mailed you. Place cards will be used at the tables, hence members not sending in acceptance cards will not be provided for.

**Table Assignments**—Assignments at the tables will be made in the order in which they are received. The members are urged to respond promptly. Use the addressed envelope in mailing the acceptance card. Mail your acceptance at once!
